



## Date Controlled Groups

### Introduction

With Date Controlled Groups your items are reordered at the specified schedule and moved to groups based on the "time left until deadline". The move will only take place at the time(s) set in the scheduler recipe. With this you can easily transform your groups to buckets with specified priorities.

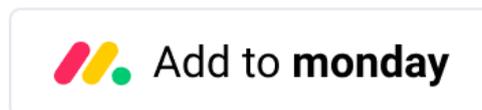
The Date Controlled Groups app is developed by monday.com power users and is available on the monday.com marketplace. When downloaded from the marketplace the app is installed in trial mode (10 days) and can be unlocked through the [Excellent Team](#) shop at any time.

### Installation

When you have already installed this app (e.g. in trial mode) you can skip to the [Configuration](#) section. There is no difference between the trial version or the paid version.



By clicking the image above you add this app to your monday.com account. In case you have multiple accounts, please select the correct account in the upper right corner. During the installation you are asked to authorize the app (see section below).

After installation of the Excellent Team app into your monday.com account you can add the app recipe(s) to your boards. You do this by clicking the integrations and find the monday App you are interested in.

## Authorize the app

During the installation of the app in your monday.com account the required permissions (scope) for this app were shown. The app does not store user access tokens but the monday.com platform will grant the permissions shown during the installation for 60 seconds to the app. All actions will be performed with the user credentials of the user that installed the app.

## Configuration

There are two recipes available that need to be active on the same board.



**Every time period** reorder the items in groups specified in the "Date Controlled Group" recipes

[Add to board](#)

With the scheduler recipe you define at which moment (each day, each N<sup>th</sup> day of the week and so on) and at which hour the items in your board are reordered based on the recipe that define the groups

**Caution:** the hour specified in the schedule is not exact. The actual moment the items are reordered can be up to 20 minutes past the specified hour.



On scheduled event check **this date** and when due in **duration** move item to **this group**.

The other recipe defines what the criteria is to move the item(s) to the group(s) specified. You can use this recipe as many times you need it on your board to specify different groups for different durations.

**Caution:** the duration can be specified in different units. The app always calculates back to hours and therefore specifying minutes or seconds does not have any effect.

Besides triggering the movement of items on the scheduled event you can also build a **custom automation** (like button click or status change) to trigger this movement. The app's action shows up in the **custom automation** builder.

## Usage

You can build multiple recipes where recipes can check different date columns. When you try to add a recipe for a given data column to move to a specified group (target group) and that target group is already used in another recipe with the same data column, the app will not add the recipe to the board and gives a warning notification.

When multiple recipes try to move an item to multiple target groups the recipe which is closest to the time the reordering takes place will win. All other recipes for that item will be ignored. With this you get the items which are closest to the due date in your top groups.

You can also enter a minus sign to specify where to move items where the due date has passed. This can be used to move items to "archiving" groups. When combined with standard monday.com automations the historic items can also be moved to another board.

As an example: the set of recipes below resulted in the board shown underneath. In this example the circled dates triggered the move to that group.
